PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH ANNOUNCES 11 TO 15 YEARS IN PRISON FOR MAN WHO SHOT WOMAN IN THE FACE

Survivor of Incident Had Numerous Surgeries, Lost Eye

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced that Timothy Addie, 48, was sentenced to 11 to 15 years in prison for shooting a woman in the face, causing her to lose an eye. Addie was found guilty of Felonious Assault with a three-year firearm specification, a 2nd Degree Felony; and Having Weapons Under Disability, a 3rd Degree Felony. Addie was sentenced yesterday by Summit County Court of Common Pleas Judge Tammy O'Brien. Addie received the maximum possible sentence for the Felonious Assault conviction.

"Timothy Addie got a rare opportunity that most do not when they choose to shoot a weapon – a second chance to stop and re-think what he'd done. Yet he still chose to re-cock his weapon and violently alter someone's life forever," said Prosecutor Kolkovich. "My thoughts are with the survivor and her loved ones as she continues her courageous recovery."

In September 2023, Addie was arguing with the victim when he pulled out a gun and attempted to shoot her. The gun jammed, and Addie re-cocked the gun and shot her in the face. Testimony from multiple witnesses and surveillance video from the location of the crime identified Addie as the shooter. When Akron Police arrived at the scene, they found the victim still alive and transported her to the hospital. She had at least four surgeries and lost an eye as a result of the shooting.
