PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH ANNOUNCES LIFE IN PRISON WITHOUT PAROLE FOR WOMAN WHO RAPED CHILD

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced that Kristina Jacobson, 39, was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole for raping an infant. Last November, codefendant Scott Jacobson, 45, was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole for his role in this offense and several others. Both have been designated as Tier III sex offenders.

Last week, a Summit County jury found Kristina Jacobson guilty of the following charges:

- One count of Rape a 1st Degree Felony;
- Two counts of Illegal Use of Minor or Impaired Person in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance both 2nd Degree Felonies; and
- One count of Gross Sexual Imposition a 3rd Degree Felony.

In August 2024, Scott Jacobson pleaded guilty to the following charges:

- Two counts of Rape, both with a Sexually Violent Predator Specification a 1st Degree Felony;
- Five counts of Pandering Obscenity Involving a Minor or Impaired Person a 2nd Degree Felony;
- Five counts of Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor a 2nd Degree Felony; and
- Two counts of Gross Sexual Imposition a 3rd Degree Felony.

"Kristina Jacobson abused an innocent child's vulnerability and inability to defend or advocate for herself. There is simply no excuse for this abhorrent crime, and I'm grateful my assistant prosecutors and the court have made that clear," said Prosecutor Kolkovich.
