## PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH ANNOUNCES ADDITIONAL CONVICTION IN CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT CASE

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced that Jason Smith, 48, pleaded no contest to severely starving and abusing a child in his care between the years of 2020 to 2024. His co-defendant, Angela Smith, 43, was convicted earlier this month after pleading no contest on July 7.

Jason and Angela Smith both pleaded no contest to the following charges:

- One count of Felonious Assault a 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Felony;
- Two counts of Endangering Children a  $2^{nd}$  Degree Felony; and
- One count of Endangering Children a 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony.

"No child should ever have to endure what this child has survived. I will always fight to protect our children, and I will keep working to ensure these two offenders are brought to justice," said Prosecutor Kolkovich. "I want to thank Summit County Children Services, the Akron Children's Hospital staff, and the Akron Police Department for their dedicated work in ensuring this child's safety."

Both Jason and Angela Smith are scheduled to be sentenced on September 11, 2025, at 2:30 p.m.
