PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH RELEASES STATEMENT ON SUMMIT METRO PARKS ATTACK CASE

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich released the following statement regarding the attack of a woman in the Summit Metroparks in August 2024. In connection with this incident, Issac Armour, 34, was indicted on one count of Kidnapping, a first-degree felony; one count of Abduction, a third-degree felony; and two counts of Gross Sexual Imposition, each a fourth-degree felony.

"After reviewing the results of clinical evaluations, the State accepted the findings of multiple medical professionals and experts that the Defendant's severe mental disease prevented him from appreciating the wrongfulness of his actions at the time of the offense. The court also accepted the findings and ruled that the defendant is not guilty by reason of insanity. He will be committed to a mental health facility and will be subject to court order as a mentally ill person for up to 16.5 years.

My thoughts are with the survivor of this incident as she continues to heal. I also want to thank the bystanders who stepped in to protect the survivor and stop the attack."
