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PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH ANNOUNCES CONVICTION FOR RAPE AND SEXUAL ABUSE OF 5-YEAR-OLD

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced that Dominic Galloway, 37, of Cuyahoga Falls, was found guilty of raping and sexually abusing a child under the age of 13 in his care. After further investigation, authorities found numerous explicit images of children on several electronic devices belonging to Galloway.

Galloway has also been designated as a Tier III sex offender, which requires him to register every 90 days with the local sheriff for the rest of his life if he is ever released from prison

A Summit County Jury found Galloway guilty of the following charges:

- Three counts of Rape of a Child Under 13 Years of Age – each a 1st Degree Felony;
- Six counts of Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor or Impaired Person – each a 2nd Degree Felony;
- Five counts of Illegal Use of Minor or Impaired Person in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance – each a 2nd Degree Felony;
- Four counts of Gross Sexual Imposition of a Child Under 13 Years of Age – each a 3rd Degree Felony; and
- Eight counts of Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor or Impaired Person – each a 4th Degree Felony.

“At such a young age, this child showed extraordinary courage and bravery in coming forward and testifying at trial. I also want to thank the Cuyahoga Falls Police Department and the many medical professionals who cared for this child in the Akron Children’s Hospital Emergency Department, CARE Center, and through her continued care outside the hospital. Their dedication and compassion helped ensure she received the support she needed,” said Prosecutor Kolkovich.

Galloway is scheduled to be sentenced on September 1, 2026 at 10 a.m. He faces a life sentence.

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
