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PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH ANNOUNCES 14 TO 17.5 YEARS IN PRISON FOR CHILD PREDATOR

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced that Gregory Demoss, 45, of Akron, was sentenced to 14 to 17.5 years in prison for pandering child sexual abuse material. In May, Demoss pleaded guilty to eight counts of Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor or Impaired Person, each a 2nd Degree Felony.

Demoss has also been designated as a Tier II sex offender, which requires him to register every 180 days with the local sheriff for 25 years when he is released from prison.

“The possession and distribution of child sexual abuse material is never an isolated incident. Behind every image is a child who has been victimized, and the continued circulation of this material means that harm can persist long after the initial abuse. I will always fight to protect our children,” said Prosecutor Kolkovich.

In February 2024, Akron Police Officers were notified of Gregory Demoss possessing and sharing child sexual abuse material. After further investigation, authorities found thousands of explicit images and hundreds of videos of child sexual abuse material on an electronic device belonging to Demoss.

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
