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PROSECUTOR KOLKOVICH ANNOUNCES LIFE SENTENCE FOR RAPE AND SEXUAL ABUSE OF 5-YEAR-OLD

AKRON, OH – Today, Summit County Prosecutor Elliot Kolkovich announced that Dominic Galloway, 37, of Cuyahoga Falls, was sentenced to life in prison for raping and sexually abusing a child under the age of 13. After further investigation, authorities found numerous explicit images of children on several electronic devices belonging to Galloway. Galloway will be eligible for parole after 31 to 35 years.

Galloway has also been designated as a Tier III sex offender, which requires him to register every 90 days with the local sheriff for the rest of his life if he is ever released from prison

In July, A Summit County Jury found Galloway guilty of the following charges:

- Three counts of Rape of a Child Under 13 Years of Age – each a 1st Degree Felony;
- Six counts of Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor or Impaired Person – each a 2nd Degree Felony;
- Five counts of Illegal Use of Minor or Impaired Person in Nudity-Oriented Material or Performance – each a 2nd Degree Felony;
- Four counts of Gross Sexual Imposition of a Child Under 13 Years of Age – each a 3rd Degree Felony; and
- Eight counts of Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor or Impaired Person – each a 4th Degree Felony.

“No child should ever have to endure this kind of abuse. We must continue working together as a community to prevent child abuse and exploitation, and to ensure that children who come forward are heard, supported, and safe. I will always fight to protect our children,” said Prosecutor Kolkovich.

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
